



**Opportunity Scholarship
\$500**

HearthStone of Wisconsin is offering one \$500 opportunity scholarship to a resident of Sheboygan County. Applicants must be identified as, and enrolled in a program for, students with an identified intellectual disability, traumatic brain impairment, or autism. The scholarship is awarded to students who are intending to attend and enrolled/enrolling in a university, technical college, vocational school, or an approved apprentice program.

Distribution of the scholarship monies are made directly to the applicant's school upon successfully completing their first term.

Members of the Board of Directors of HearthStone Wisconsin will decide the distribution of the scholarships and the committee will interview applicants.

Determination of the scholarship is by the committee based on the following criteria:
